

APPLICATION FOR ENGLISH LESSONS

- Students whose curriculum has courses coded ACS 105 and ACS 205, will have the same grades in the transcripts of the students who are successful in both courses. Students who have failed in ACS 105 and/or ACS 205 courses and those who have not attended both will take ENG 121. The course in which the student fails will be deleted from the transcript and the course that the student succeeds in, depending on the student's request, will be deleted from the transcript. In case a student does not take ENG 121, they must take both courses with the code ACS 105 and ACS 205 and be successful in both.
- Students whose curriculum has courses coded ACS 106 and ACS 206 will have the same grades in the transcripts of the students who are successful in both courses. Students who have failed in ACS 106 and/or ACS 206 courses and those who have not attended both will take ENG 122. The course in which the student fails will be deleted from the transcript and the course that the student succeeds in, depending on the student's request, will be deleted from the transcript. In case a student does not take ENG 122, they must take both courses with the code ACS 106 and ACS 206 and be successful in both.
- Students whose curriculum has courses coded RPW 305 and RTW 405 will remain the same in the transcripts of the grades of the students who have succeeded in one of these courses and will be deleted from the transcripts of the courses they failed. Students who have failed both courses or do not take any of the courses will take ENG 221. Students who take one of the courses coded RPW 305 and RTW 405 and succeed are not needed to take ENG 221.
- Students whose curriculum has APS 308 and PCS 406 coded courses will have their grades remained the same in their transcripts and will be deleted from the transcripts of the courses they failed. Students who fail both courses or do not take any of the courses will take ENG 222. Students who take one of the APS 308 and PCS 406 courses and succeed do not need to take ENG 222.
